FOR BOYS AND GIRLS ENTERING 5TH, 6TH, 7TH, AND 8TH GRADE in Fall 2010

Our traveling soccer program is open to both boys and girls entering grades 5, 6, 7, & 8 this Fall. Players are separated into leagues by age.

This exciting program gives children the opportunity to improve their soccer skills by competing against teams of the State Line District (SLD) of the Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association (WYSA). District clubs include Big Foot, Burlington, Delavan, East Troy, Elkhorn, Lake Geneva, Whitewater, and Williams Bay. Players are required to travel, but car-pooling is used to provide rides for those without transportation. Teams also hold about two practices each week.

You must register by June 5th to play soccer in the Fall '10 and Spring '11!

This very successful program combines both the Fall and Spring Traveling registrations into **one registration and fee**. Our traveling team games are scheduled on Saturdays and some Sunday afternoons.

The seven (7) game Fall schedule starts on September 11th and ends on October 22th. The seven game Spring season starts on April 9th and ends on May 23rd, 2010. The coaches will provide schedules, team rosters, and maps to other community fields.
