



SPRING 2010 U10 SOCCER REGISTRATION

FOR BOYS AND GIRLS in 3rd AND 4th GRADE

Our U10 soccer program is open to both boys and girls in grades 3 & 4 this Spring. We will attempt to form balanced teams based on prior soccer experience. We will also try to maintain an equal boy/girl ratio between all the teams. Teams will consist of a mix of players from the varying schools. Players living in the same household may be on the same team if they are in the same age division. **Registrations received after March 19th are not guaranteed team placement.** Any openings will be filled on a first come basis. Once teams are filled, late registrants will be placed on a waiting list. If no placement is made the registration fee will be refunded.

You must register by March 19th to guarantee team placement for the Spring season!

Practices will be held once a week at the FAYSA soccer fields located behind Luther Elementary School or at the soccer fields located at the other elementary schools in Fort Atkinson. Practice times will be determined after the teams are formed. Practices are important to a team's performance and a commitment to attend is requested.

Our U10 games are scheduled on Friday evenings @ 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. The six (6) game Spring schedule starts on April 16th and the last game is held on Saturday morning, June 5th during Soccer Fest. The coaches will provide schedules and team rosters.
